Proposals due June 6, 2023.	TBD	Resource conservation districts (RCDs), University of California Cooperative Extension (UCCE), universities, and non-profit organizations are eligible to apply. Eligible entities are encouraged to partner with a Groundwater Sustainable Agency (GSA). The Planning Committee is speaking with the Sierra Valley RCD and UCCE Plumas-Sierra to determine the level of interest in applying for this technical assistance.
California Department of Water Resources (DWR): Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) Implementation Round 2	Funding request to assist with all aspects of Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) implementation including data collection and data management, annual reports, five-year updates to the GSP, projects and management actions, and grant administration.	\$5,450,000	Draft awards anticipated to be announced in May 2023, final award announcements expected in October 2023, with agreements signed by January 2024.
