

ORDINANCE NO. 83-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE SIERRA VALLEY GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT ENACTING A MANAGEMENT CHARGE TO PURCHASE METERS AND INSTALL THEM.

The Board of Directors of the Sierra Valley Groundwater Management District DOES ORDAIN as follows:


Section 1. The intent of this ordinance is to establish a management charge for the purpose of purchasing and installing meters in the District, which charges will be an estimate of the amount necessary to purchase and install the meters. It is further intended that if the charges result in too much or too little money being collected, further adjustments of charges will be made.

Section 2. The Board of Directors finds that the reasonable Management charge per acre shall be \$.10 , and all parcels forty acres or less shall be \$ 4.00 , and each individual lot forty acres or less shall be \$ 4.00 , and said fees are hereby established and fixed.

The foregoing ordinance was duly passed and adopted by the Board of Directors of the Sierra Valley Groundwater Management District, State of California, at a regular meeting held the 4th day of March , 1983 by the following vote:
