

**SIERRA VALLEY GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT
ORDINANCE NO. 21-02**

Enacting a large-capacity well management charge for fiscal year (2021-2022)

The Board of Directors of the Sierra Valley Groundwater Management District **DOES ORDAIN** as follows:

Section 1. A large capacity well management charge for the fiscal year 2021-2022 shall be collected on all metered wells that are capable of pumping 100+ gpm within the District. The total large capacity well management charge for the fiscal year 2021-2022, for the purpose of paying the costs of initiating, carrying on, and completing all of the powers, projects, and purposes for which the District is organized is fixed at \$200.00 per well per year.

Section 2. The large capacity well management charge shall be billed by the District and payments shall be returned to the District address of record.

Section 3. Any operator or person who intentionally violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction, and may be required to pay a fine to the Agency of not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500). Interest shall accrue on the billed amount for any charges not received or postmarked within thirty days of the billing date at a rate of two percent per month.

Section 4. The amount of an unpaid management charge, together with any penalty and interest thereon, shall constitute a lien on that land.
